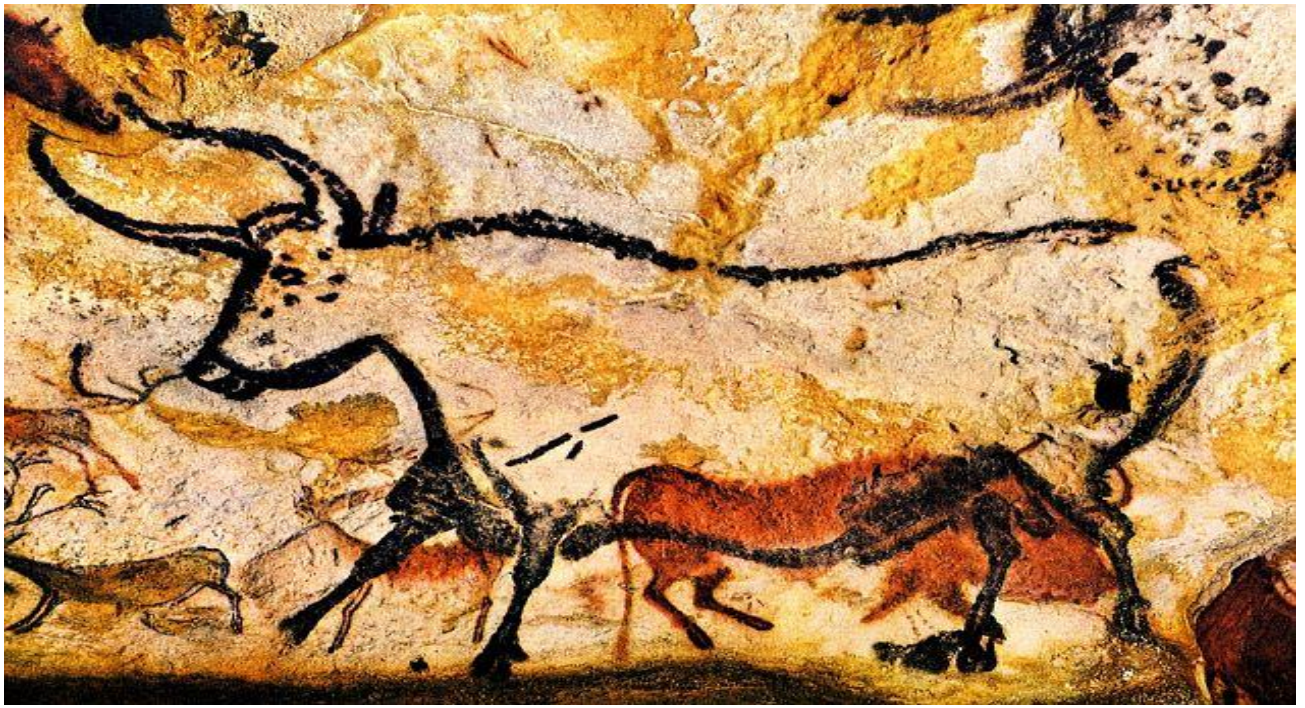
STEP INTO THE STONE AGE.
